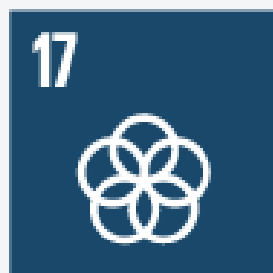
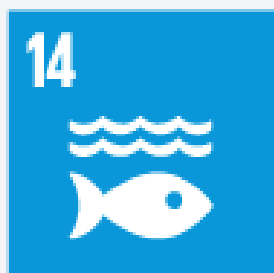
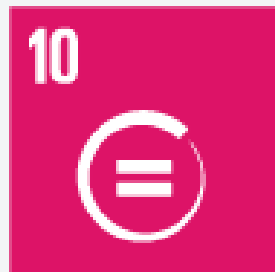
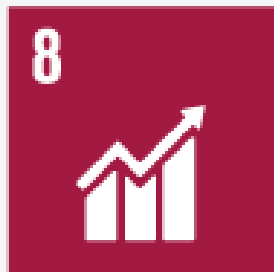
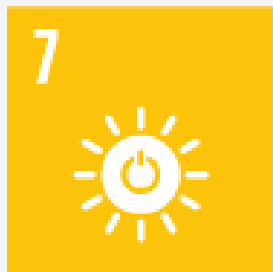
# Scandinavia – A Region of democratic peaceful welfare states and local governance

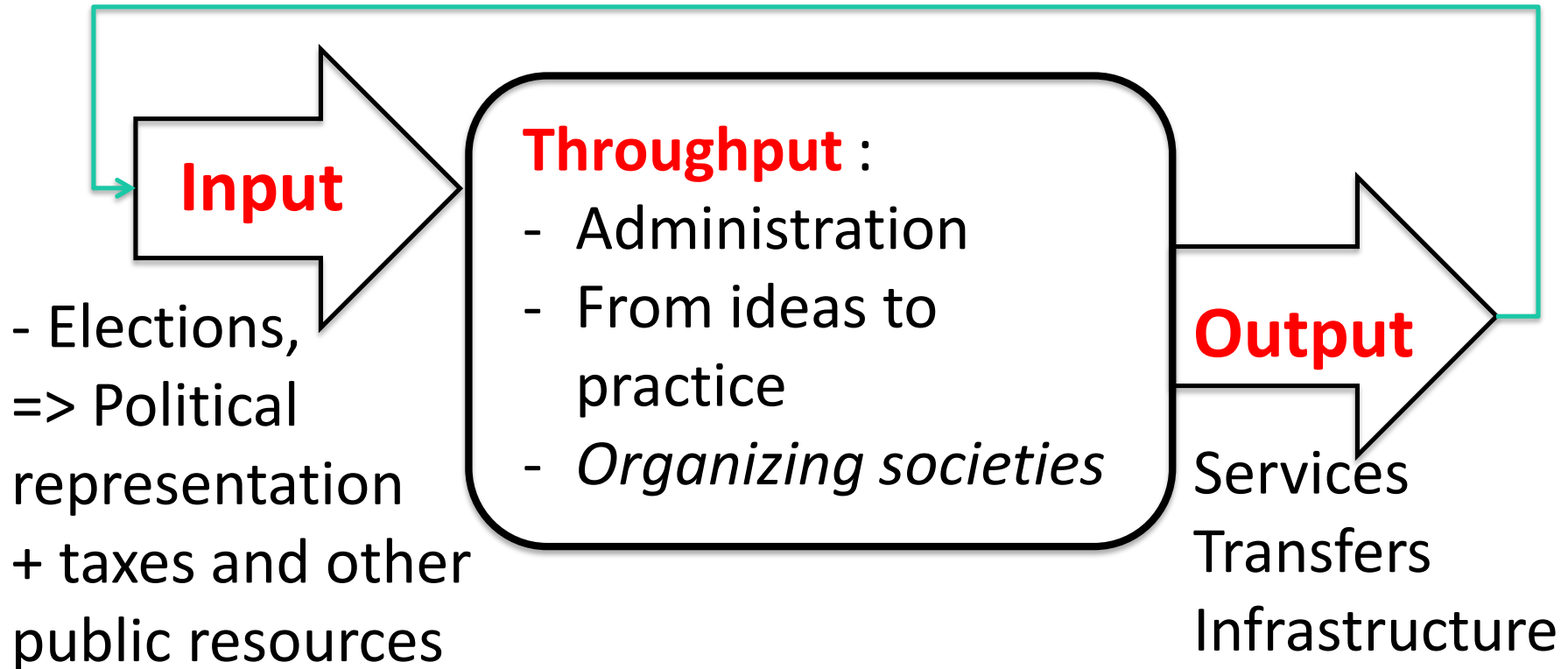

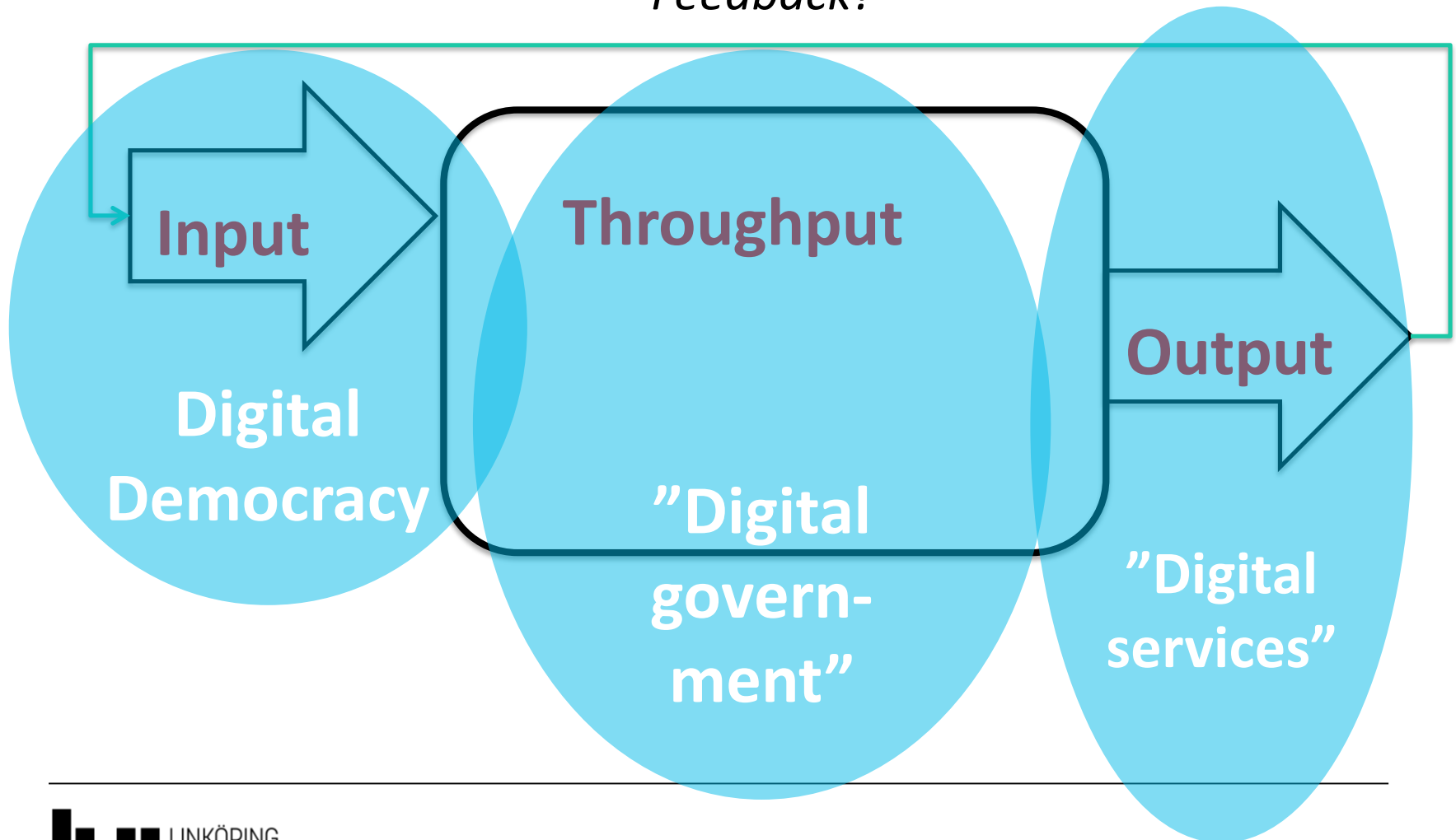
